J. F. CHITTY III HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

POLICIES

Amended November, 2011

The J. F. Chitty III High School Scholarship is established as an annual scholarship to be awarded to one qualified student from the following High Schools in Cleveland County in the amount of \$1,000.00 each: Shelby High School, Kings Mountain High School, Crest High School and Burns High School.

ELIGIBILITY

The recipient must be a graduating senior who has been accepted as a first year student into an accredited college, university, community college or trade school for the year the scholarship is granted. The award will be based upon need, priority given to those students who have not received multiple scholarships from other sources. A minimum GPA of 2.8 will be required. Partiality will not be shown to children or family members of REALTORS®; however, their association would not prevent receiving the award.

EXCEPTIONS: In cases of exceptional need other applicants may be considered for additional awards subject to approval of the Board of Directors.

SELECTION

A High School Scholarship Committee will be appointed by the current President of the Association each year composed of four members, one to be assigned to each selected High School. Each committee member will work with counselors from each selected high school to compile a list of candidates from applicants who submit applications furnished by the Cleveland County Association of REALTORS®. After consideration applicants will be chosen from each school for interviews by the committee members who will make the final decision. Each committee member will attend the award ceremony at their assigned school to present the scholarship to the student.



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PAYMENT

Upon selection the Executive Officer will be provided the name, parent(s) name(s), address, Phone Number, Student ID (assigned by school) and name and address of the Financial Aid/Cashier's office of the college/university for which enrollment has been confirmed for each recipient. The EO will then send a letter to the student inviting them and their parent(s) to attend the scheduled August General Meeting and Luncheon for recognition. In July a check made payable to the student and the school and will be sent to the address provided with instructions to the school that endorsement would be required. At the time the student endorses the check he/she would inform the school whether to use the funds for the first term or split it between terms of that school year.

DEFAULT

Scholarship funds must be used within the calendar school year of the award unless application for an extension is made and approved. If the student elects to not use the scholarship another recipient will be chosen.
